WORKING GROUP 5-ADRAFT REGIONAL AGREEMENT FOR THE USE BY THE BROADCASTING SERVICE
OF THE BAND 1 605 - 1 705 kHz IN REGION 2

PREAMBLE

Noting No. 480 of the Radio Regulations, which provides: "In Region 2, the use of the band 1 605 - 1 705 kHz by stations of the broadcasting service shall be subject to a plan to be established by a regional administrative radio conference..."

Taking account of the pertinent provisions of the International Telecommunications Convention and the Radio Regulations in force and fully respecting the sovereign right of each country to regulate within its territory the use of the frequency band 1 605 - 1 705 kHz by the services to which this band is allocated in Article 8 of the Radio Regulations and to reach special arrangements regarding these services with such countries as it may consider appropriate, without prejudice to other countries;

seeking to facilitate mutual understanding and cooperation among country Members of Region 2 in achieving a satisfactory broadcasting service in band 1 605 - 1 705 kHz and, to the extent consistent with the Plan established for the broadcasting service in this band, to make provision for the Fixed and Mobile services in the band 1 625 - 1 705 kHz;

recognizing that all countries have equal rights, and that, in the application of the Plan and the provisions of this Agreement the needs of each country, and in particular those of developing countries, shall be met as far as possible; and

acknowledging that mutual protection of the broadcasting service is a major objective of all countries requiring that the mutual protection of the fixed and mobile services ensures appropriate protection to the Plan;

the delegates of the Members of the International Telecommunication Union assembled in Rio de Janeiro from 23 May to 9 June 1988 at a regional administrative conference convened pursuant to the International Telecommunication Convention (Nairobi, 1982), have adopted, subject to approval by the competent authorities of their respective countries, the following provisions relating to the broadcasting service in Region 2 for the frequency band between 1 605 - 1 705 kHz.

ARTICLE 3

3.3 The Contracting Members undertake, to the extent possible, to avoid or to reduce any harmful interference [that may be caused by a broadcasting station operating in conformity with the Agreement or a fixed or mobile station operating in accordance with the Radio Regulations to stations of the same status].

Noting that provision No 480 of the Radio Regulations, as adopted by WARC-1979, provides that: "In Region 2, the use of the band 1605-1705 kHz by stations of the broadcasting service shall be subject to a plan to be established by a regional administrative radio conference, ..."

PROPOSED NEW PARAGRAPH FOR 2.2 OF SECTION 2 OF ARTICLE 5

"When the IFRB receives a request for an assignment to a station in a non-allotted channel, it shall ascertain that the requesting administration has already used all the allotted channels in the area in question and has also requested and obtained the approval of the countries which receive, inside their national frontiers, a higher level of field strength than the E_{nom} reduced by the co-channel protection ratio."

PART C TO ANNEX 4

TECHNICAL CRITERIA

1. 1 kW transmitter power.
2. 90 degrees electrical height non-directional antenna.
3. Channel spacing of 10 kHz and carrier frequencies which are integer multiples of 10 kHz, beginning at 1 610 kHz.
4. On the condition of not causing more interference to the Plan than would result from the use of 1 and 2 above, station powers to a maximum of 10 kW and directional antenna may be used.
5. As an exception, on the condition on not causing interference to the Plan, channels not allotted to the allotment area may be used.
