PROPOSED COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

Committee 1 - Steering Committee

(Chairman and Vice-Chairmen of the Conference, Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen of Committees)

Terms of reference: To coordinate the work of the Committees and establish the schedules of meetings.

Committee 2 - Credentials Committee

Terms of reference: To verify the credentials of each delegation

Committee 3 - Budget Control Committee

Terms of reference: To determine the organization and the facilities available to the delegates, and to examine and approve the accounts for expenditure incurred throughout the duration of the Conference.

Committee 4 - Technical Committee

Terms of reference: To establish the technical bases for the work of Committees 5 and 6.

Committee 5 - VHF Broadcasting Committee

Initial terms of reference:

- a) To examine the present situation as regards VHF broadcasting in the European Broadcasting Area;



- b) to propose to the Plenary Meeting the steps which, in the light of such examination, are considered to be essential, or which are necessary as a result of the entry into force of the Radio Regulations, Geneva, 1959.

Committee 6 - UHF Broadcasting Committee

Terms of reference: To draft agreements and associated plans for the use of UHF broadcasting in the European Broadcasting Area.

Committee 7 - Editorial Committee

Terms of reference: To perfect the form of texts prepared by Committees, without altering their sense.

TABLE OF DISTANCES TO BE USED FOR PREPARING THE FREQUENCY ASSIGNMENT
PLAN IN BANDS I, II AND III, FOR PROPAGATION OVER THE MEDITERRANEAN

The following is a table showing distances against power; the distances are those below which the frequency assignments will have to be taken into consideration for preparation of the plan, when propagation is over the Mediterranean.

Experience with this type of circuit, as mentioned in paragraph 1.1.3 of Document No. 64 (Cannes, 1961) leads to the following figures:
